## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That STEPHEN HANKINS

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Walla Walla River

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1894;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 2

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point 2 rods west of the northeast corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence west 15 rods and 10 ft.; thence south 38 rods more or less to a point 50 ft. north of the center of the OR&N Railroad Co.'s track; thence easterly and parallel with said railroad track to a point 2 rods west of the east line of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 2; thence north 42 rods more or less to the place of beginning, containing 4 acres, more or less. ALSO: Commencing at the northeast corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence west 2 rods; thence south to a point within 50 ft. of the center of the present OR&N Co.'s track; thence in an easterly direction and parallel with said road to the east line of said Quarter; thence north to the place of beginning, containing 0.5 acre, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
