CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That W. D. HARDESTY,

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1896;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one miner's inch measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.25 acre in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 2

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at a point 100 ft. south of the northeast corner of Block 11, in Evans' Addition to Milton, Umatilla County, Oregon, running thence west 183.65 ft. to the west line of said Block 11; thence south 50 ft.; thence east 183.65 ft. to the east line of said Block 11; thence north 50 ft. to the place of beginning, excepting and reserving therefrom a strip of land 14 ft. wide across the west end thereof for road and alley purposes.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
