## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That T. W. HEWITT

of Milton, State of Oregon has a right to the use of  
the waters of Walla Walla River  
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority  
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1868;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one miner's inch  
measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant  
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.38 acre in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 12

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. E., being within the following described tract: Beginning on the westerly line of Block 1 in Gross' Addition to Milton, according to the duly recorded plat thereof, at a point where the southerly line of the alley through said Block 1 intersects the easterly line of Vine St. as shown by the duly recorded plat of said Gross' Addition; running thence easterly toward a point on the west line of Advent St. 20 ft. southerly from where the southerly line of said alley intersects the westerly line of said Advent St., a distance of 100 ft.; thence southerly parallel with the easterly line of Vine St., 95 ft.; thence westerly 100 ft. more or less to a point on the westerly line of said Block 1, 100 ft. southerly from place of beginning; thence northerly along the westerly line of Block 1, 100 ft. to the place of beginning.

ALSO: From a point where the easterly line of Vine St. is intersected by the southerly line of the alley running through Block 1 of Gross' Addition to Milton, Umatilla County, Oregon, according to the duly recorded plat thereof, running thence easterly toward a point on the westerly line of Advent St. 20 ft. southerly from where the southerly line of the said alley intersects the westerly line of said Advent St., a distance of 100 ft.; thence southerly parallel with the easterly line of Vine St., 95 ft. to a place of beginning; Running thence from said place of beginning southerly parallel with the easterly line of Vine St., 50 ft.; thence westerly 100 ft. more or less to the westerly line of Block 1 in said Gross' Addition to Milton, to a point 150 ft. southerly from where the southerly line of the alley through the said Block 1 intersects the easterly line of Vine St.; thence northerly along the westerly line of Block 1, 50 ft.; thence easterly 100 ft., more or less to the place of beginning.

ALSO: Beginning on the westerly line of Block 1 of Gross' Addition to the town of Milton, at a point where the southerly line of the alley through said block intersects the easterly line of Vine St. as shown on the duly recorded plat of said Addition; running thence westerly at right angles to the westerly line of said Block 1, 10 ft.; thence southerly parallel with the westerly line of said Block, 100 ft.; thence easterly at right angles 10 ft.; thence northerly along the westerly line of said Block, 100 ft. to the place of beginning.

ALSO: Commencing at a point on the westerly line of Block 1, in Gross' Addition to Milton, Umatilla County, Oregon, according to the duly recorded

plat thereof, 100 ft. southerly from the intersection of the southerly line of the alley running through said Block 1, and the easterly line of Vine St.; thence westerly at right angles to the westerly line of said Block 1, 10 ft.; thence southerly parallel with the westerly line of said Block, 50 ft.; thence easterly at right angles 10 ft.; thence northerly along the westerly line of said Block 1, 50 ft. to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

*The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
