## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CORA E. JONES

of Freewater

, State of

, has a right to the use of

the waters of Walla Walla River

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Omatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12 and at page 9 that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1885;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

> 3.7 acres in NW4SE4 Section 2

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: In Unatilla County, Oregon: Beginning at the 1/16 cor. on the west side of the southeast quarter (SE) of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence east 429.6 ft.; thence north 293 ft. to the south line of the alley on the south side of Block 7, in the town of North Milton; thence westerly along the south line of said alley and said south line produced westerly to the north and south center line of said Sec. 2; thence south to the point of beginning;

ALSO: Commencing at the northwest corner of the SWASE, of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence east 20 rds; thence south 9 rods; thence west 20 rods; thence north 9 rods to the place of linning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
