CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That S. L. KEY

of R. #2, Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1877 for 12 acres, 1893 for 5 acres, and 1901
for 3.52 acres.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half
miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

20.52 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 2,
T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the follow-
ing described tract: Commencing at a point 5 chains and 70 links west of the north-
east corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M.; thence west 14 chains
and 30 links to the northwest corner of the aforesaid 1/16 Sec.; thence south along
the west line of said 1/16 Sec. to the right of way of the OR&N Co.'s railroad;
thence southeasterly along the north line of said right of way to a stone at the
southwest corner of the land deeded to Laura Peabody by W. T. Wright and Laura
Wright; thence north 17 chains and 68 links to place of beginning, containing 20
acres.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use
herein described.
