and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Imatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 39; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.73 acre in SEINWI Section 12

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at the northeast corner of Block 10 of Columbia Heights Addition to Milton, Umatilla County, Oregon, running thence westerly along the south line of Park St. 112 ft.; thence southerly at right angles 180.18 ft.; thence easterly at right angles 112 ft. to the southeast corner of said Block 10; thence northerly along the easterly line of said Block 10 a distance of 180.18 ft. to place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
