CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EDWARD MCKENZIE

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1868;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.58 acre in SW¹/₄ NE¹/₄
Section 12

T. 5 N. R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: In Umatilla County, Oregon: Commencing at a point on the north line of Second St. 140 ft. easterly from the southwest corner of Block 1, in the town of Milton, said County and State, according to the duly recorded plat thereof: Running thence easterly along the south line of said Block 1, 120 ft.; thence northerly parallel with Mill St. 120 ft.; thence westerly parallel with Second St., 60 ft.; thence northerly parallel with Mill St., 120 ft.; thence westerly parallel with Second St., 60 ft.; thence southerly parallel with Mill St., 240 ft. to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
