CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That L. H. MOON

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1891 for 2 acres, and 1893 for 2.44 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half
miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

4.44 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 2,

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the follow-
ing described tracts: Commencing at a point 17 rods 10 ft. west of the northeast
corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., thence west 9 rods 6.5 ft.;
thence south to a point 50 ft. distant from the center of the OWR&N Railroad;
thence parallel with said railroad in a southeasterly direction to a point due
south of the place of beginning; thence north to the place of beginning, contain-
ing 2 acres, more or less. ALSO: COMMENCING at a point 27 rods west of the north-
east corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence west
15 rods; thence south to a point within 50 ft. from the center of the OWR&N rail-
road track; thence in an easterly direction and parallel with said railroad track
to a point within 27 rods of the east line of the above described quarter; thence
north to the place of beginning, containing 2.75 acres, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use
herein described.
