CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That SARAH A. MUMFORD

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1889;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half
miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

6.78 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 2

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the
following described tracts: Beginning at a point 24 rods east and 20 ft. south
of the center of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., and running thence south 26 &
2/3 rods; thence east 12 rods; thence north 26 & 2/3 rods; thence west 12 rods
to the place of beginning. ALSO: Beginning at a point 32 rods and 3 ft. west
and 20 ft. south of the center of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., and running
thence south 58 & 2/3 rods; thence northwesterly along the base of the hill 34
rods 11 ft.; thence north 6.5 rods; thence east 12 rods; thence north 26 & 2/3
rods to a point 20 ft. south of the east and west center line through Sec. 2;
thence east 12 rods to place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use
herein described.
