and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

l acre in SEASEA Section 2

T. 5 N. R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point on the west line of DeHaven St. in Milton, Oregon, 30 ft. west and 20 rods south of the northeast corner of the St of Set of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence south along the west line of DeHaven St., 218.51 ft.; thence west 415.5 ft.; thence north 203.51 ft.; thence east 165.1 ft.; thence north 15 ft.; thence east 250.5 ft. to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
