CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GROVER PORTER

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one miner's inch
measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.24 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 12

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the follow-
ing described tract: Commencing at a point 195 ft. northeasterly from the north-
east corner of Block 7, in McCoy's Addition to Milton, in Umatilla County, Oregon,
said point of beginning being in a direct line with the northerly line of said
Block 7; running thence northwesterly at right angles 60 ft. more or less to the
south line of Quartz St. as extended; thence northeasterly along the south line of
Quartz St. as extended to the north and south center line through Sec. 12, in
T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M.; thence south along said center line of said Sec. 12,
84 ft. more or less to a point in a direct line with the north side of the afore-
said Block 7; thence southwesterly 120 ft. more or less to the point of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use
herein described.
