## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WILLIAM C. PROCHNOW

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Walla Walla River  
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1893;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one miner's inch measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.33 acre in SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>  
Section 2

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at a point 119.37 ft. north of the southeast corner of Lot 18 in Evans' Addition to Milton, as shown by the duly recorded plat thereof; running thence north 89.37 ft.; thence west 168.36 ft.; thence in a southerly direction 89.37 ft.; thence east 168.06 ft. to the place of beginning; reserving a strip of land 14 ft. wide along the west side of Lot 18 for a private alley for the occupants of Lots 11, 18 and 19.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
