for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1888;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.8 acre in SEASEA Section 2

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point 61-7/333 rods south of the northeast corner of the S\frac{1}{2} of SE\frac{1}{2} of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence south 11 rods; thence west 18 rods; thence north 11 rods; thence east 18 rods to the place of beginning, in Umatilla County, Oregon, EXCEPTING the north 4.5 rods of said tract.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
