CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That. J. W. SALING

of Freewater , State of Oregon

, has a right to the use of

the waters of Walla Walla River

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1885;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

3.23 acres in SE4SE4 Section 2

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: In Umatilla County, Oregon: Beginning 53-9/20 rods west of the southeast corner of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., and running thence west 15-11/20 rods; thence north 26-252/333 rods; thence east 11-11/20 rods; thence south 26-252/333 rods to the place of beginning, containing 2.6 acrss. ALSO: Commencing at a point 35-28/37 rods north and 53 rods west of the southeast corner of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence west 14 rods 13 ft.; thence south 9 rods; thence east 14 rods 13 ft.; thence north 9 rods to place of beginning, containing 133-1/11 sq. rods, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations convained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
