CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. H. SAMUEL

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

3.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 2

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at a point 18 rods west of the southeast corner of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence west 21 rods; thence north 131.7 ft.; thence east 5 rods; thence north 144.8 ft.; thence east 16 rods; thence south 276.5 ft. to the place of beginning. ALSO: Beginning at a point 7-326/333 rods north of the southeast corner of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence west 230 ft.; thence south 70 ft.; thence east 230 ft.; thence north 70 ft. to the place of beginning. ALSO:

10 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 11

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: The N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 11, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., EXCEPTING and reserving therefrom a strip of land described as follows: Commencing at the southeast corner of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence south 20 ft.; thence west 18 rods; thence north 20 ft.; thence east 18 rods to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said Decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
