## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRANK E. SHELTON

of Milton

, State of Oregon

, has a right to the use of

the waters of

Walla Walla River

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Omatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1885;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, it limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

2 acres in SE4SE4 Section 2

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point 36-28/37 rods north and 69 rods west of the southeast corner of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence south 1 rod; thence in a southeasterly direction along the foot of the hill 33 rods to a point; thence northerly 20-1/3 rods to the place of beginning. ALSO: Commencing at a point 36-28/37 rods north and 68 rods west of the southeast corner of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., and running thence west 16 rods; thence north 10 ft. more or less to a point 43-9/37 rods south of the north line of the S½ of the SE½ of said Sec. 2; thence east 16 rods; thence south 10 ft. more or less to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
