CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. N. STONE

409 E. Main St.

of Walla Walla, State of Washington, has a right to the use of

the waters of Walla Walla River

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12 at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one miner's inch measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.4 acre in SE 1/4
Section 12

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the follow-

ing described tract: Beginning at a point at the intersection of the east line of Mill St. and the north line of Quartz St., and running thence northeasterly along the north line of Quartz St., 130 ft.; thence at right angles 135.33 ft.; thence southwesterly at right angles 130 ft. to the east line of Mill St.; thence southeasterly along the east line of Mill St. 135 ft. more or less to the point of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
