## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OSCAR WALLACE

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Walla Walla River  
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority  
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1890;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one miner's inch  
measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,  
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.34 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 2

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the follow-  
ing described tracts: Lot 19, Block 8 of Wright's Addition to North Milton,  
Umatilla County, Oregon; ALSO: Beginning at a point in line with the west line  
of Lot 17, Block 8, Wright's Addition to Milton, said point being on the north  
line of land of J. E. Hoon 12 ft.; more or less, south of the southwest corner  
of said Lot 17; thence south 50 ft. along the west line of said Lot 17 if pro-  
duced; thence east parallel with the north line of said J. E. Hoon's land 200  
ft.; thence north 50 ft. to point in line with east line of Lot 20, of said  
Block 8; thence west 200 ft. to place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations  
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use  
herein described.
