CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That R. W. WALTER

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1870;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one miner's inch measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.39 acre in SE¹/₄SE¹/₄
Section 12

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the fol-

lowing described tract: In Umatilla County, Oregon: Beginning at a point on the south line of Nichols St., as shown on the plat of Nichols Addition to Milton, 60 ft. westerly from where said line is intersected by the west line of Cherry St. as shown on the duly recorded plat of Nichols Second Addition to Milton; running thence southerly at right angles to the south line of Nichols St. 135 ft.; thence westerly at right angles 170 ft.; thence northerly at right angles 135 ft. to the south line of Nichols St.; thence easterly along said line 170 ft. to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
