## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRANK WHITE

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Walla Walla River  
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority  
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1887;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half  
miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,  
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

4.17 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 2

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the follow-  
ing described tracts: Commencing at a point 36-28/37 rods north and 34 rods west  
of the southeast corner of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence west  
16 rods; thence south 10 rods; thence east 16 rods; thence north 10 rods to the  
place of beginning. ALSO: Beginning at a point 39 rods west of the southeast  
corner of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence west 14-9/20 rods;  
thence north 26-252/333 rods; thence east 19-9/20 rods; thence south 18-7/9 rods;  
thence west 5 rods; thence south 7-326/333 rods to the point of beginning; and  
ALSO: A tract of land: Beginning at a point 53-9/20 rods west and 26-252/333 rods  
north of the southeast corner of said Sec. 2, running thence east 3 rods; thence  
north 9 rods; thence west 3 rods; thence south 9 rods to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations  
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use  
herein described.
