## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That. H. E. WIN

of Freewater , State of Oregon

, has a right to the use of

the waters of Walla Walla River

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12 , at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1881 for 3 acres, 1894 for 2 acres, and 1896 for 3 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed. One are half miner's inches per agre measured at the point of diversity.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to where is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial well as follows:

8.0 acres in SEINE Section 3

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning 761 ft. south of the point where the south line of the OREN Co.'s right of way crosses the line running north and south through the center of the NEt of Sec. 3, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence south along said center line 712 ft.; thence N. 87° 50° East 308.5 ft.; thence S. 73° 30° East 213 ft.; thence north 691 ft. to a point 613 ft. south of the south line of said OREN Co.'s right of way; thence north of west 515.6 ft. to the place of beginning, containing over 8 acres of land.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of usc herein described.
