CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That G. R. MINEAR

of R. #1, Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of West Fork Crockett Branch of Little Walla Walla River for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12 at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1893 for 2.25 acres, 1901 for 1.25 acres, and 1903 for 0.50 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

4.0 acres in NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 35, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at the southwest corner of the SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 35, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence east 16 rods; thence north 40 rods; thence west 16 rods; thence south 40 rods to the place of beginning, containing 4 acres, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
