CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That N. W. MUMFORD

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
 the waters of Little Walla Walla River
 for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1880 for Tract No. 1, and 1903 for Tracts
 Nos. 2 and 3;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half
 miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,
 if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

NOTE: The acreage described above is within the following described tracts:

BEGINNING at the northwest corner of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 3, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. W. M., and running thence south 100 rods; thence east 80 rods; thence north on the center line of Sec. 3 to the OWR&N Co.'s railroad right of way; thence northwesterly along the right of way to where north line of Sec. 3 crosses it; thence west along said north line of Sec. 3 to place of beginning; and EXCEPTING therefrom a 5-acre tract in the southeast corner described as follows: Beginning at the southeast corner of premises described above and running thence west 25 rods; thence north 35.5 rods; thence southeasterly to a point on the north and south line through the center of Sec. 3, 28.5 rods north of the place of beginning; thence south to the place of beginning; ALSO: Less a piece of land described as follows: Beginning at a point 1286.4 ft. south and 266 ft. N. 74° 39' west from the northeast corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 3, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., and running thence N. 74° 39' W. 255.1 ft.; thence north 100 ft. more or less to the OWR&N Co.'s right of way; thence southeasterly along the said right of way 250 ft.; thence south 965.4 ft. to the point of beginning, containing 5.55 acres, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
 The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
