for the purposes of irrigation; (from December 1st to September 1st of each year)

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Morrow County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 73; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1887 for the irrigation of twenty (20) acres and from 1896 for the irrigation of eleven (11) acres; 1887 for

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.34 cubic feet per second as of date 1887 and 0.18 cubic feet per second as of date 1896.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Three (3) acres in NW_2^1 of NE_4^1 ; eleven (11) acres in SW_2^1 of NE_2^1 ; seventeen (17) acres in NW_4^2 of SE_4^2 ; Sec. 27, Tp. 1 N. R. 23 E., W. M., in Morrow County,
