CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HARRY L.OBERT

, has a right to the use of

the waters of North Fork Walla Walla River

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1889;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

1.5 acres in SW4NW4 Section 24

T. 5 N., R. 36 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: In Umatilla County, Oregon, to-wit: Beginning at a point which is N. 0° 17' E. 650.1 ft. from the west quarter-corner of Sec. 24, T. 5N., R. 36 E. W. M., running thence N. 0° 17' E. 584.3 ft.; thence S. 71° 56'E. 223.6 ft.; thence S. 66° 39' E. 227.1 ft. to a stone monument; thence S. 0° 17' W. 500 ft. more or less to the foot of the bluff on the south side of the Walla Walla River; thence northwesterly along the said bluff 450 ft. more or less to the point of beginning, containing 5 acres, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
