CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ESTATE OF ANNA OLINGER

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County; and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1873;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half min's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

1.4 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
3.3 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 18

T. 5 N., R. 36 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at a point 59 rods west and S. 20° 45' E. 12 rods from the center of Sec. 18, T. 5 N., R. 36 E. W. M., running thence south 30° 58' E. 253.8 ft.; thence S. 51° 37' W. 50 rods more or less to the center of the Walla Walla River; thence northwesterly along the center of said river to a point S. 51° 37' W. of the point of beginning; thence N. 51° 37' E. 55 rods more or less to the point of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
