CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That E. L. OWNBEY

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1905;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

1.65 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 1
T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M.,
and
1.5 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 1,

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tracts: Commencing at the center of Sec. 1, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence south on the line between the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec., 825 ft.; thence west 96 ft.; thence south 30 ft. to a point 50 ft. west of the present channel of the tract of land by this instrument agreed to be conveyed; thence west 297 ft.; thence south 316 ft.; thence east 421 ft. to a point 50 ft. west of the present channel of the said Tum-a-lum river; thence in a northwesterly direction parallel to the said channel of said Tum-a-lum River to the said point hereinbefore mentioned and described as the initial point of beginning, containing 2- $\frac{2}{3}$ acres. ALSO: The westerly three (3) acres of the following tract: Beginning at a point 1721.28 ft. south and 50 ft. west of the center of Sec. 1, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence west 417.44 ft.; thence north 521.08 ft.; thence east 417.44 ft.; thence south 521.08 ft. to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
