CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

, has a right to the use of

the waters of Little Walla Walla River

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12 at page 9 that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1885 for 1 acre, and 1908 for 9 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

10 acres in NW NE

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point 39,70 chains west and 6.76 chains south of the northeast corner of Sec. 26, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence south 13.77 chains; thence east 7.97 chains; thence north 11.27 chains; thence west 4.99 chains; thence N. 200 54° W. 2.674 chains; thence west 2.08 chains to the point of beginning, containing 9.61 acres, more or less.

(NOTE: The 1908 right will be limited to be used between October 15th and June 1st of each following year.)

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
