CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That G. O. PEARSON

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Ford Branch of Walla Walla River for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1888;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.83 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at a point 20 rods north and 40 rods west of the southeast corner of Sec. 27, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence north 20 rods; thence west 40 rods, more or less to the west line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 27; thence south 20 rods; thence east 40 rods, more or less to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
