CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Milton , State of Oregon , has a right to the use of the waters of Little Walla Walla River

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umetilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12 , at page 9 ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1900;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.53 acre in NE4SW4 2.0 acres in SE4SW4 Section 1,

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at a point 1272 ft. south and 30 ft. east of the northwest corner of the NELSW; of Sec. 1, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence south 434-7/12 ft.; thence east at right engles 300-8/12 ft.; thence north at right engles 434-7/12 ft.; thence west at right engles 300-8/12 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 3 acres, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
