and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1891 for 0.69 acre, and 1892 for 0.26 acre;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.69 acre in SEINE 0.26 acre in SWINE Section 2

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tracts: Lots 1 to 8 inclusive, in Block 60, of Freewater, Oregon; ALSO: Commencing at the northeast corner of Block 5 in Even's Addition to Milton, in the town of Freewater, Umatilla County, Oregon, running thence west 100 ft. along the north line of said Block; thence south 116 ft. to a point 6 ft. north of the east and west center line of said Block; thence east 100 ft. to the east line of said Block; thence north 116 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 0.26 acre, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
