CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WARREN W., and CINDERELLA ROEDER

of Box 291, Freewater , State of Oregon

, has a right to the use of

the waters of West Branch of Ford Branch of Little Walla Wella River

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1880 for 3 acres, 1893 for 6 acres, 1902 for 8 acres, and 1903 for 2 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

19 acres in NW4NW4 Section 35

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at a point 80 rods east of the scuthwest corner of the NW\frac{1}{4}\text{NW}\frac{1}{4}\text{ of Sac. 35, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., thence north 80 rods to the Sec. line; thence west 46-2/3 rods; thence at a right angle south 48 rods; thence at a right angle south 32 rods; thence at a right angle east 30 rods to the place of beginning, containing 20 acres, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
