CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That N. S. RUSAW

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half
miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

1.86 acres in NW¹/₄NE¹/₄
Section 12,
T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the follow-
ing described tract: Commencing at a point from the southeast corner of Block 1
Ireland's Addition to Milton, Umatilla County, Oregon, running easterly along
the extended south line of said Block 535.4 ft. southeasterly parallel with the
center line of Grover St., 10 ft. to a place of beginning; running thence north-
erly parallel with the center line of Grover St. 210.2 ft.; thence westerly at
right angles 50.3 ft.; thence northerly at right angles 44.9 ft.; thence due
east 442.9 ft.; thence north at right angles 25 ft.; thence east at right angles
69.47 ft., more or less to the center of the channel of the Walla Walla River;
thence southerly up the center of said channel to a point 142 ft. distant at
right angles from last described line; thence west 175 ft. more or less to
intersect with the line drawn parallel with and 10 ft. south of the south line
of Block 1 in said Ireland's Addition to Milton, Umatilla County, Oregon, if
said south line were extended easterly; thence westerly along said parallel
line 223.5 ft. more or less to the place of beginning, containing 1.86 acres.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use
herein described.
