CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ERNEST SCHEUCH

Box 05
of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1905;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use); is as follows:

2.81 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 1
T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at a point 542 ft. east of the southwest corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 1, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., and running thence north 486 ft.; thence N. 84° 30' E. 290 ft. to the west bank of the Tum-a-lua River; thence south 515 ft. more or less along and up said west bank of said river to its intersection with the east and west center line of said Sec. 1; thence west 290 ft. more or less to the point of beginning, containing 3 acres, more or less.
ALSO: A right of way from the southwest corner of said land for a road 15 ft. wide, running west over the land adjacent thereto, to the public road.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
