CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That . school district No. 108, Umatilla County,

has a right to the use of

the waters of McCoy Branch of Little Stream

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1893;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

2.0 acres in SWINEL Section 36

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at the northeast corner of the Wig of the Nig of the SWINEL of Sec. 36, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence south 18 rods; thence at right angles west 8 rods and 14.5 ft.; thence at right angles north 18 rods; thence east 8 rods 14.5 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 1 acre, more or less.

ALSO: Commencing at the southeast corner of the NW of the SW NE of Sec. 36, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running themes north on the east line of said NE, 22 rods more or less to a point 18 rods south of the northeast corner of said NW; thence west parallel with the south line of said NW a distance of 8 rods 14.5 ft.; thence south 22 rods more or less to a point on the south line of said NW 8 rods 14.5 ft. went of the place of beginning; thence east on said south line to the place of beginning, it being the intention of this instrument to convey an acre of ground more or less, lirectly south of and adjoining the acre of ground now owned and used by School District No. 108 for school purposes.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
