CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1890 for 1 acre, 1894 for 1.67 acres, and 1905 for 1 acre:

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

3.67 acres in SWISWI Section 1,

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at a point 550.55 ft. north and 34.55 ft. west of the 1/16 sec. corner of the W2 of the line between Secs. 1 and 12, in T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence down and with the center of the main channel of the Walla Walla Rivor, in a northwesterly direction 780 ft., more or less to where said river crosses the County road running from Milton, Oregon, to Wa 'a Walla, Wn.; thence in a southwesterly direction 385 ft. to intersection of said road with Mill Race of the Peacock Mill Co., thence southeasterly up the middle of the channel of the said race 583 ft. more or less to the point of beginning, containing 4.89 acres.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use

herein described.
