CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MARY JANE HIATT STANFORD

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1868;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

1.5 acres in SW¹/₄NE¹/₄

Section 12

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point on the east line of Walnut St., 250 ft. south from the northwest corner of Block No. 2, Riverside Addition to Milton, Umatilla County, Oregon, running thence northeasterly 282 ft. to the bank of the Walla Walla River and along the south boundary line of lands owned by S. I. Birdsell; thence southeasterly along the bank of the said Walla Walla River to the north line of land deeded to Harry U. Cooper and wife by warranty deed dated March 7, 1913; thence along the north line of said described tract of land conveyed to the said Harry U. Cooper 12.75 rods more or less to the west boundary line of Block 1 in said Riverside Addition to Milton; thence south along the west line of said Block 1, 22 ft.; thence southwesterly along the north line of Second St., and the south line of Block 5, 160 ft. to the southwest corner of said Block 5; thence north along the west side of said Block 5, 157.73 ft. more or less to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
