CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GEO. STARKEL

of Walla Walla, State of Washington, has a right to the use of
the waters of McCoy Branch of Little Stream
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1886 for 2.75 acres, 1887 for 7.0 acres, and 1894 for 2.75 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

9.4 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 25,

3.1 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 36,

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point 8 rods south of the southwest corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 25, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., and running thence north 30 rods to a point in the west line of said Sec. 25; thence at right angles east 80 rods; thence at right angles south 30 rods; thence at right angles west 80 rods to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
