CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HENRY D. STARKEL

, State of Oregon

, has a right to the use of

the waters of Little Stream, a branch of Tumalum River

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1891;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

5.6 acres in NW4SE4 Section 36,

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at the northeast corner of the NW4SE4 of Sec. 36, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence west 21 rods 13.5 ft.; thence south 40 rods; thence east 21 rods 13.5 ft.; thence north 27 rods 5.5 ft. more or less to a point 209 ft. south of the northeast corner of the NW4SE4 of said Sec. 36; thence east 208.5 ft.; thence north 209 ft.; thence west 208.5 ft. more or less to the place of beginning, containing 6.5 acres, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
