and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla.

County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 3; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1885;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one miner's inch measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.5 acre in NW4SW4 Section 18

T. 5 N., R. 36 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at the northeast corner of the SW4SW4 of Sec. 18, T. 5 N., R. 36 E. W. M., and running thence north along the line running north and south through the center of SW4 of Sec. 18 to a point where said line intersects the center of the Walla Walla River; thence northwesterly along the center line of said river to the southeast corner of land deeded to C. O. Bowman on May 9, 1893; thence southerly along the line of C. O. Bowman land to the southwest corner of said land; thence south along the land deeded to C. W. Harder on Nov. 10, 1898 to the north line of the SW4SW4 of Sec. 18, and thence east to the point of beginning; subject to the easements of the P. P. & L. CO. and the City of Milton. Also EXCEPTING a triangular tract sold by John Spencer and wife to Milton City on Sept. 21, 1914, recorded Book 89, page 152 of County Records.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
