and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12 , at page 39 ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1893;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

> 0.54 acre in SWANE Section 2

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: All of Lot 7 of Evens' Addition to Milton, Umatilla County, Oregon, EXCEPTING the following: Commencing at the northeast corner of said Lot 7, running thence west 135 ft.; thence south 100 ft.; thence east 135 ft.; thence north 100 ft. to the place of beginning. ALSO: Commencing at the southeast corner of said Lot 7, running thence west 75 ft.; thence north 121 ft.; thence east 75 ft. to the east line of said Lot 7; thence south 121 ft. to place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
