CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ... A. THOMASON

of Freewater , State of Oregon , has a right to the use of the waters of West Branch of Ford Branch of Little Walla Walla River for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the ('der Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1879 for 7 acres, and 1902 for 1.68 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

8.68 acres in NELSWA Section 35,

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point 10 rods south of the northeast corner of the SW1 of Sec. 35, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence west 80 rods; thence south 20 rods; thence east 80 rods; thence north 20 rods to the place of beginning, containing 10 acres, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of usc herein described.
