## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ANNA M. TROUTT

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Crockett Branch of Walla Walla River  
for the purpose of Irrigation, Domestic and Stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1894;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

3 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 26,  
T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point 30 rods east of the northwest corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 26, T. 6 N., R. 35 E., running thence east 16 rods; thence at right angles south 40 rods; thence at right angles west 16 rods; thence at right angles north 40 rods to the place of beginning, containing 4 acres of land, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
