## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That R. F. VANCIL

of R.#1, Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Little Stream, a branch of Tumalum River  
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1891;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

9.3 acres in NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>  
Section 36,

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tracts: Commencing at a point 20 ft. south and about 36 rods 6 ft. east of the center of Sec. 36, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being in the center of the irrigation ditch as now located and established; running thence south along the center of said ditch or channel 38 rods 13 ft.; thence east 21 rods 13.5 ft., more or less to a point 58 rods 3 ft. east of the line running north and south through the center of Sec. 36; thence north 38 rods 13 ft.; thence west 21 rods 13.5 ft. more or less to the point of beginning, containing 5.5 acres, more or less. ALSO granting a right of way for a road 20 ft. wide extending east from the center section line a distance of 58 rods 3 ft.

ALSO: Commencing at a point 45 rods 3.5 ft. south and 36 rods 6 ft. more or less east of the northwest corner of the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Sec. 36, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., said point being in the center of the channel of the irrigation ditch as now located; running thence northerly down the center of said irrigation ditch 44 rods to a point 20 ft. south of the line running east and west through the center of said Sec. 36; thence west 12-8/11 rods; thence south 44 rods; thence east 12-8/11 rods to the place of beginning, containing 3.5 acres, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
