CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HELEN J. WALKER

of Waitsburg, State of Washington, has a right to the use of the waters of Middle Brook for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1892;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

7.0 acres in NW 1/4 Section 14, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point 1155 ft. west and 1800.85 ft. south of the northeast corner of the W 1/2 of the south fraction of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 14, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., thence running south 377.15 ft.; thence east 557.5 ft.; thence at right angles north 377.15 ft.; thence west 557.5 ft.; being Lot 5 of McMinn Tracts. ALSO: A tract lying immediately west and adjacent to the above described tract, being 11 rods 4. ft. wide, east and west, and 377.15 ft. long, north and south.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
