CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JENNIE WARFIELD

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1893 for 0.63 acre, and 1900 for 1.54 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

2.17 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 12

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at the intersection of the northerly line of Martin St. with the easterly line of Grover St. in Ireland's Addition to Milton, running thence southerly along the easterly line of Grover St. a distance of 30 ft.; thence at right angles in a northeasterly direction parallel with the produced northerly line of Martin St. to the center of the channel of the Walla Walla River; thence northerly along the center of said river channel to its intersection with the said produced northerly line of Martin St.; thence southwesterly along said produced northerly line of Martin St. to the place of beginning, containing 0.5 acre, more or less.

ALSO: Beginning at a stake on the north line of Martin St. in Ireland's Addition to Milton, Umatilla County, Oregon, N. 64° 46' E. 450 ft. from the stone monument at the intersection of the north line of Martin St. with the north and south line running through the center of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12, T. 5 N. R. 35 E. W. M., thence running north 331 ft. to the center of the Walla Walla River; thence following the center of said river upstream to the north line of Martin St.; thence along the north line of Martin St. 64° 45' W. 460 ft. to the point of beginning, containing 1.67 acres, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
