## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That AMANDA WILDER

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Walla Walla River  
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority  
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1891 for 1.25 acres, and 1905 for 1.85 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half  
miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,  
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

3.10 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 1

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the follow-  
ing described tracts: The east 2 acres of that certain tract or parcel of land  
beginning at a point 1721.28 ft. south and 50 ft. west of the center of Sec. 1,  
T. 5 N., R. 35, E. W. M., running thence west 417.44 ft.; thence north 521.08 ft.  
thence east 417.44 ft.; thence south 521.08 ft. to the place of beginning, said  
tract containing 5 acres, more or less.

ALSO: Beginning at a point 684. ft. north and 925 ft. east of the southwest  
corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 1, running thence north 209 ft.; thence east  
361 ft.; thence south 209 ft.; thence west 361 ft. to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations  
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use  
herein described.
