the waters of Lewis Spring Branch for Tract No. 1, and East Prong of the Little Walla Walla River Spring Branch for Tract No. 2; for the purpose of Irrigation and Domestic for Tract No. 1, and Irrigation for Tr.#2,

and that, said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Unatillar of the County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12 5000 at page 19 that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1880 for Tract No. 1, and 1875 for Tract No. 2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed: one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

M., running thence east 80 rods and 1 ft.; thence at right angles north 30 rods; thence at right angles west 80 rods and 1 ft.; thence south 30 rods to the place of beginning, containing 15 acres, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said docrea.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
