CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That W. A. Heard, Paris Ward, and World War Veterans' State Aid Commission of Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring branch a tributary of Coquille River for the purpose of domestic under Permit No. 6459 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 17, 1924;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW<sup>1</sup> NE<sup>1</sup>, Section 36, Twp. 28 S., Rge. 14 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

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and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Paris Ward: Lot 1, Section 25, Twp. 28 S., Rge. 14 W., W. M., Coos County, Oregon.

W. A. Heard: Lot 2, Section 25, Twp. 28 S., Rge. 14 W., W. M., Coos County, Oregon.

World War Veterans' State Aid Commission: That part of Lot 3, Section 25, Twp. 28 S., Rge. 14 W., W. M., within the following-described tract: Beginning at the center of Section 25, Twp. 28 S., Rge. 14 W., W. M., running thence South along the subdivision line 34.84 chains to the meander line of the right bank of the Coquille River; thence North 79 degrees East 3 chains along the meander line of the right bank; thence North 76 degrees East 5 chains along the meander line of the right bank; thence North 74 degrees East 4.35 chains along the meander line of the right bank; thence North 31.86 chains to the subdivision line running East and West through the center of said Section 25; thence West along said subdivision line 11.99 chains to the place of beginning, containing 40 acres, together with all riparian right fronting and abutting the same.

NOTE: This certificate is issued to correct and supersede that certain certificate of water right issued January 12, 1929, to W. A. Heard, Victor Sell, and Paris Ward and recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 8, Page 7861, so as to describe correctly and record the place of use.
