**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** HENRY R. WAHOSKE

of 1534 N.E. Weidler St., Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Dick Springs a tributary of Oswego Lake for the purpose of

Domestic, pools and aquariums and operation of a ram under Permit No. 11669 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 13, 1935;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.2 cubic foot per second, being 0.17 c.f.s. for pools; 0.02 c.f.s. for operation of ram and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 18, Township 2 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

 Section 18  
 Township 2 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
